Tickets are available online and in-person, both at the event and in advance in a temporary pop-up box office. However, we highly recommend booking online as events are expected to sell-out and there is no separate allocation for in-person box office sales, nor is there a difference in price between online or in-person. All prices shown are inclusive of ticket agent fees unless stated otherwise. Free events require a pre-booked ticket unless event has 'drop-in' in its listing.

In-person: FBTS Pop-up Box Office, c/o NB Library, 13 School Road, North Berwick, EH39 4JU (10th June - 1st August, during library opening hours). During the festival there will be a box office at the Lodge Grounds, open between 10.00AM and 10.00PM daily (2nd - 11th August).

Tickets are sent as an e-ticket, which can be presented on your mobile device at the door. Alternatively, print the e-ticket at home and bring it with you. (The Citizen Ticket app is no longer available. Your QR code will be in your confirmation email.)

Programme details are correct at the time of going to press. Fringe By The Sea reserves the right to alter or cancel events. Tickets are non-refundable unless an event is cancelled. Check the website and social media feeds for all the latest news and updates.

Accessibility: All venues at Fringe By The Sea are wheelchair accessible. Please let a member of stewarding team know of your needs on arrival. If you have a carer requiring a ticket, please contact info@fringebythesea.com in advance. An accessible drop off point is located on St Baldred's Crescent. Limited accessible seating is available in each venue. This is allocated on a first come, first serve basis. An accessible seated platform is available for standing events in the Big Top and is reservable on a first come, first serve basis. Please email info@fringebythesea.com with any queries.

Concession tickets: Where applicable, concession tickets are available for children. Babes in arms go free.

Age restrictions: Please take note of age suitability of events, where stated. Fringe By The Sea is family friendly and we encourage you to bring kids along to enjoy many of our gigs. Under 16s must be accompanied by an adult.

Venues: The festival venue at the Lodge Grounds is open from 10AM to 11PM daily. As our festival is outdoors, it can get chilly in the evenings and our venues are sited on uneven ground - please dress appropriately. No smoking or vaping inside our venues.

Latecomers: Events start punctually. Members of the audience may not be permitted entry after the beginning of events.

Entry: Please follow all signage for queuing, entering and exiting our venues. There may be a different point of entry from exit at each venue. Our staff will direct you to seats, where relevant. Please follow their instruction.

Lost property: Lost property will be stored at the Box Offices for the festival duration and at our office afterwards. Any items not collected within a fortnight of the festival from The Lighthouse will be disposed.

Dogs: Well behaved dogs are welcome on-site and in venues, with the exception of evening standing gigs in the Big Top.

Welfare: We have first aid helpers on site. Speak to a member of festival staff if you require first aid assistance. North Berwick Youth Project will be based in the Park Life tent and welcome secondary school age children.

Talks and interviews with fascinating personalities from a wide range of professions is spearheaded by actor *Richard E Grant*, journalist and Mastermind presenter *Clive Myrie*, author and **The Times** columnist *Caitlin Moran* and one of Britain's most-loved Olympians, *Eddie 'The Eagle' Edwards*.

The Masterclass Tent is crammed full of wonderful experiences from cocktail showcases to poetry workshops. With captivating experts sharing their brilliant knowledge, we encourage you to give something fresh a go - you might just discover a new passion in your life.

The **SSE Renewables Wild Side** space also comes front and central into the hub, showcasing our environmental programme and how best we can care for our wonderful natural heritage.

Coulters Makers Market returns with brilliant artisans presenting their beautiful wares, and this artistry expands into the delicious Street Food Village, ensuring you will all be well-nourished throughout your time with us - not to mention quenched by Scotland's favourite **Tennent's**.

Up and coming East Lothian bands will once again hit **the Lighthouse Live stage** - the talent of these young people never fails to amaze us. On the subject of young people, the *North Berwick Youth Project* is curating the new Park Life tent, which will be designed by their members.

On the first Sunday, we'll be marking the harvest festival **Lughnasadh** with a series of events, culminating in an amazing fire poem by artist *Robert Montgomery* and torchlight procession along the seafront and up into the Lodge Grounds. It's sure to be an amazing spectacle.

Inspired by sea, nature, and coast. Mugs, bowls, candlesticks, shell sculptures, tea towels, prints and paintings.

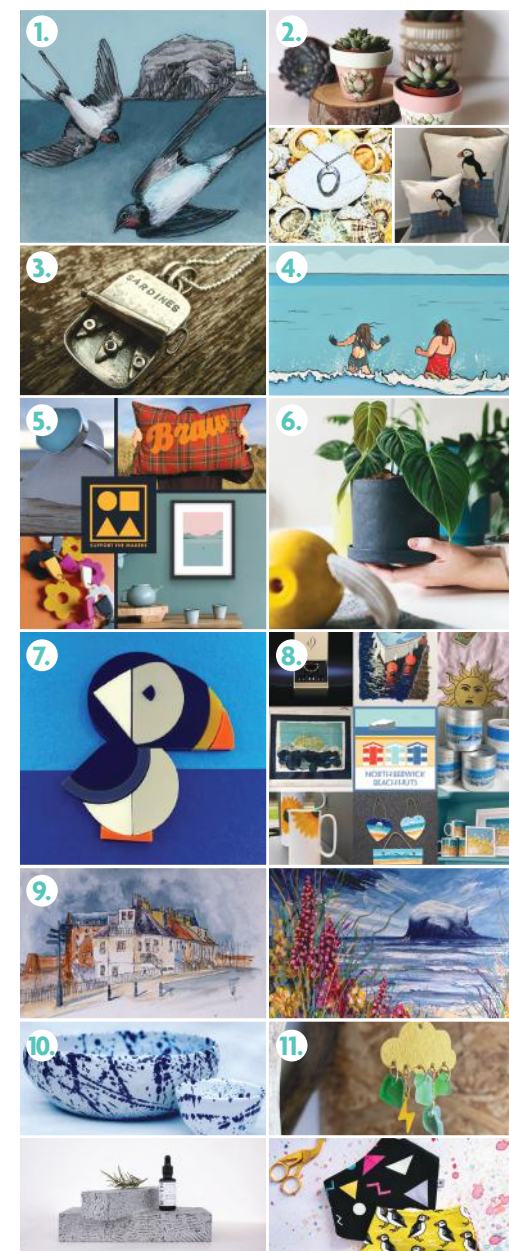

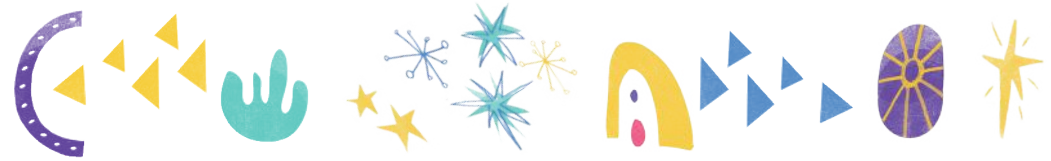
Steampunk
